

2009 Fritz Windisch Niersteiner Spiegelberg Rhh Kerner Kabinett Riesling

Varietal: 100% German Riesling

Appellation: Rheinhessen is Germany's largest wine region and lies in a valley of gentle rolling hills. Grapes are just one of many crops that share the fertile soils of this region's vast farmlands. Varied soils and the favorable climate make it possible to grow many grape varieties, old and new. Rheinhessen wines are often characterized as being soft, fragrant, medium-bodied and mild in acidity — pleasant, easy-to-drink wines.

Tasting Notes: Aromas of honeysuckle and lime, off-dry, refreshing riesling acidity. Pair well with sharp cheeses and poultry.
