



2009 Cabernet Sauvignon

100% Napa Valley
Harvested in Mid October
Average Sugar at Harvest: 25.1%

Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot, 3% Cab Franc, 2% Malbec

Appellation: Napa, Cabernet Sauvignon grapes for this wine come from two vineyard sources in the Napa Valley, Howel Mountain and Stag's Leap. The Merlot is sourced from Oak Knoll. The Cabernet Franc and Malbec are sourced from Mt Veeder.

Fermentation: Tannin management is an important factor to our producing powerful elegant wines. Primary fermentation in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. The wines are finished in 100% French oak for 14 months, which accelerates integration of fruit and oak.

Tasting Notes: Bright black cherries lead the charge, followed by dusty cocoa and roasting coffee beans. Dense texture and a fine sense of balance enhance the pleasing aromatics of blackberry, currants, vanilla bean and dark chocolate. Approachable and immediately delicious. 2008 Twenty Rows Cabernet is an agile performer that will out-step many bigger, more overbearing California Cabernets."

Comments: Rigorous vineyard management and traditional viticultural techniques are utilized in building the wines of Twenty Rows.
